Bonding is achieved within 3-4 hours, depending on the substrate's absorbency. After approximately 24 hours, full bonding strength is achieved. For bonding absorbent surfaces, apply an even layer of adhesive on both surfaces, align them precisely, and leave them for 2-4 hours.
